Students wishing to undertake a complementary major in Linguistics, and complete the degree within three years should follow this plan.

- (i) You must complete PSYC3311 Language & Cognition. This will count as a Stream A elective in your Psychology major and as a Level 3 elective in your Linguistics major.
- (ii) PSYC3XXX represents a Level 3 Psychology elective. You must then complete a *minimum* of 12 UOC from Level 3 Psychology electives including ONE course from each of the elective groups listed below.
