Agency details

On 7th May, 1981 an agreement was signed between the Australian Government and UNSW to establish a University College within the Defence Force Academy, thereby replacing the responsibilities of the Faculty effective 1st January, 1986.

The Faculty of Military Studies was established by Council on 10th July, 1967 (resolution 67/118). This resolution also created Faculty Chairs in English, History, Mathematics, Science and Engineering. The Faculty's inaugural meeting was held on 20th June, 1968 with Dean Professor Sir Leslie Martin as Acting Chairman, with Professor L. C. F. Turner later elected as Chairman.

The 10th July, 1967 agreement also indicated that there was "a view to developing the College into a separate autonomous degree-conferring body within a period of ten years". Although this idea changed over time, finally on 7th May, 1981 an agreement was signed between the Australian Government and UNSW to establish a University College within the Defence Force
