Administrative history note: The Board of Studies in General Education was formed by Council on 13th May, 1963 (resolution 63/67i). The Board's purpose was to "be responsible for courses in the humanities and social sciences for students in faculties other than the Arts and more generally for the fostering of other forms of general education" (Council resolution 63/67ii). The first meeting of the Board was held on 24th June, 1963 under Chairman Professor M. S. Brown.

The Board of Studies in General Education was dissolved on 31st December 1987, under Council resolution 86/105c on 10th November, 1986.
